

Granada High School Winterguard and Percussion Fiesta

General Information

Parking

Please see the enclosed map to identify parking areas for buses and autos. There will be attendants to assist you at the gate.

Registration

Each competing unit must register upon arrival, see map. You will receive your Event Packet at that time. PLEASE SEE THE DIRECTORS WELCOME LETTER for information on hand stamps, staff wrist bands and directors badges. Each group will have a guide to help you find your way around the area.

First Aid

First aid will be available throughout the competition in the 200 hall next to the Ticket Booth. Please be sure to have your student's emergency information in case of accident.

Refreshments

The Granada Music Boosters will have a snack bar for your convenience and enjoyment. Please encourage your students to patronize the snack bar as it helps offset the cost of hosting this event. Directors and Staff with wristbands are welcome to relax at the Directors Lounge.

Changing Areas

Competing units may change in the boys and girls locker rooms. Please see map. There are also rest rooms available in the changing areas. There will be separate rest rooms for spectators and adults.

Warm-up

Each unit will have a 10-minute warm-up period. Warm-up for Guards will be in the Small Gym. Warm-up for percussion will be in the Student Union. Weather permitting, you may warm-up in the parking areas or the non-restricted areas around Campus. Monitors will help you stay on time and guides will help you proceed to the ready area.

Performance Venues

In a drastic effort to protect the floors from damage, please note that a protective floor covering will cover the gym floor. This covering is much like the floors that Guards use in their performance, however these coverings DO NOT have gym floor striping. The centerline will be marked.

Security

We recommend that all groups provide their own security. For your protection please keep all valuables with you at all times, and have a booster or student monitor equipments. Please do not leave anything in the changing areas. Granada High School and Livermore Valley Unified School District will not be responsible for the safety of personal belongings during this event.

Floor Folding

Floor folding area will be behind the SMALL GYM (see map).

Sound Checks/Announcer/Performance Tapes

Sound checks can only be done before the competition begins. All Performance CD's and announcer sheets should be taken directly to the sound table after check-in.

Director/Staff Passes

Directors and staff for each competing will receive a limited number of complimentary passes. These passes must be displayed for admission to the performance area as well as the Directors/Staff Lounge.

ONE DIRECTOR BADGE (per school).

TWO (2) INSTRUCTOR BADGES (per guard unit) + 2 adult support wristbands.

TWO (2) INSTRUCTOR BADGES (per percussion unit) + 4 adult support wristbands

All other persons, staff or not, must purchase a wristband.

Directors Lounge:

Complimentary food and beverages will be provided for Directors, Judges and Instructors. You must have a "Director" badge or an "Instructor" badge or a "Judges" badge to enter. Wristbands are not admitted to the Lounge. Please, no students or visiting boosters.

Admission:

Admission to the show is \$10.00 General, \$8.00 students and Seniors, under 5...Free. All persons without directors/staff badges/wristbands must pay admission.

Score Packets:

Score packets will be handed out before each awards ceremony. Directors will have 5 mins. to check scores and re-caps. After 5 mins., the results are final.

Awards Ceremony

Trophies for all awards must be accepted by a uniformed member of the winning unit. In compliance with NCBA regulations only one person per performing unit will be on the floor to accept awards.

*******Equipment Helpers:*******

Any non-performing individual who is helping with equipment set-up or take-down, **MUST** have a staff wrist band or a paid attendance wrist band to enter with the performing unit. Sorry, **There will be no exceptions!!**
