

To All Directors: Please Follow These Directions.

Directors/Instructors:

You will need to buy only ONE Set of SD Memory Cards for the winterguard/percussion season. "L" Pattern Drum Majors will need only one SD card for the season.

(If you purchased SD cards for Parade/Field/Concert you will have enough cards for the season)

If you need SD Cards you can go on line <nbaonline.org> for the form to purchase cards. Allow 2 weeks for delivery.

If doing Host shows only order from the following:

Guard Set - Three SD Memory Cards - \$16.50 Per Set

Percussion Set - Two SD Memory Cards -\$11.00 per Set

"L" Patterm - One SD Memory Card for each DM - \$5.50 Ea.



If you do Championships you will need to order the following:
(Championships will have a double panel of judges)

Guard Set - Six SD Memory Cards \$33.00 per set

Percussion Set - Four SD Memory Cards \$22.00 per set

"L" Patterm - One SD Memory Card for each DM - \$5.50 Ea.

Additional Memory cards \$5.50 Each

For Guards Show, put 3 cards in a small zip lock and label the bag with your School name and also your SD cards with your school name.

For Percussion, put 2 cards in a small zip lock and label it Percussion with School name on both the Zip Lock and The SD Cards.

For Championships guards will need Six SD Cards and Percussion will need four SD Cards.
"L" Pattern Drum Majors will need only one card for the season.

Be sure to have your school name on all zip locks and your cards with your school name. Best to use a fine point black sharpie. (Remember, there are a lot of school that are AHS)

Do not include the memory card cases when you submit them at the check in station. (It is much easier for the judges not to have to remove them and put them back in the case)

At each event that you attend you will turn your Zip Lock Bag(s) at the check-in.

Your cards will be returned to you at the directors meeting with your judge's score sheets at the end of the event

Remember that these cards can be reused at each event that you attend. Once you have down loaded them into your computer you need to erase them so they will be ready for the next event.
