FOOTBALL GAMES:

- Chaperone students ensuring appropriate behavior and secure instrument safekeeping during the band's 3rd quarter break.
- Selling Granada Music Afghans/products at front game.
- Work the Snack Shack for supporters as a band representative.

BAND REVIEWS: Our Marching Band and Color Guard will compete in various band reviews this season. **THIS REQUIRES A SMALL ARMY TO MAKE EVERYTHING RUN SMOOTHLY!**

EVENING BEFORE:

Truck Crew: Load equipment truck (uniforms, large instruments and equipment)

DAY OF:

- **Bus Chaperone:** Ride bus and chaperone students
- **Truck Crew:** Unload truck at site, reload after review and unload upon return to GHS
- **Assist:** Help band and color guard prepare for competition. Help them dress, polish shoes, fix hair so it doesn't touch uniform collar and keep students hydrated.
- **Lunch Crew:** Help set, serve and clean up.

WINTER HOLIDAY PARADE: Similar to a band review but without uniforms. Students wear black pants and shoes and a white shirt. They are encouraged to wear festive attire (awards are given for best outfit).

CONCERTS (WINTER & SPRING)

BEFORE:

- Solicit and collect donations for basket raffle or you may donate an entire themed basket.
- Assist with basket assembly.

DAY OF:

- Assist in set up the afternoon of the concert.
- Sell basket raffle tickets at the door.
