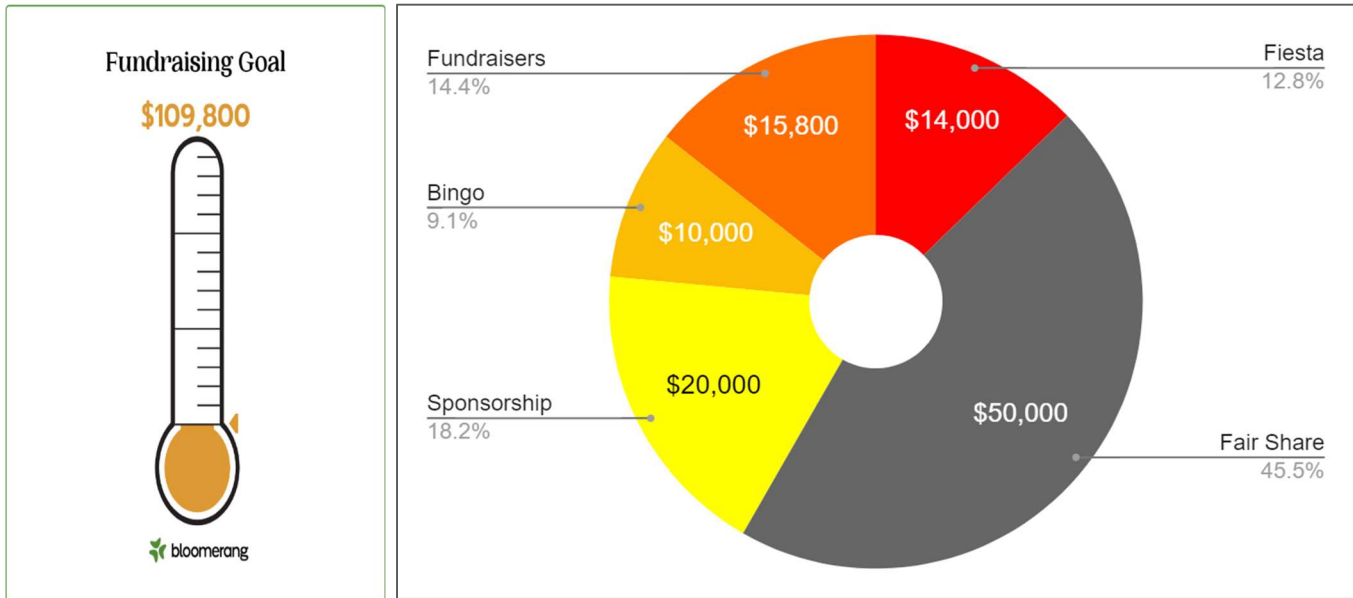

# Where does the money come from?

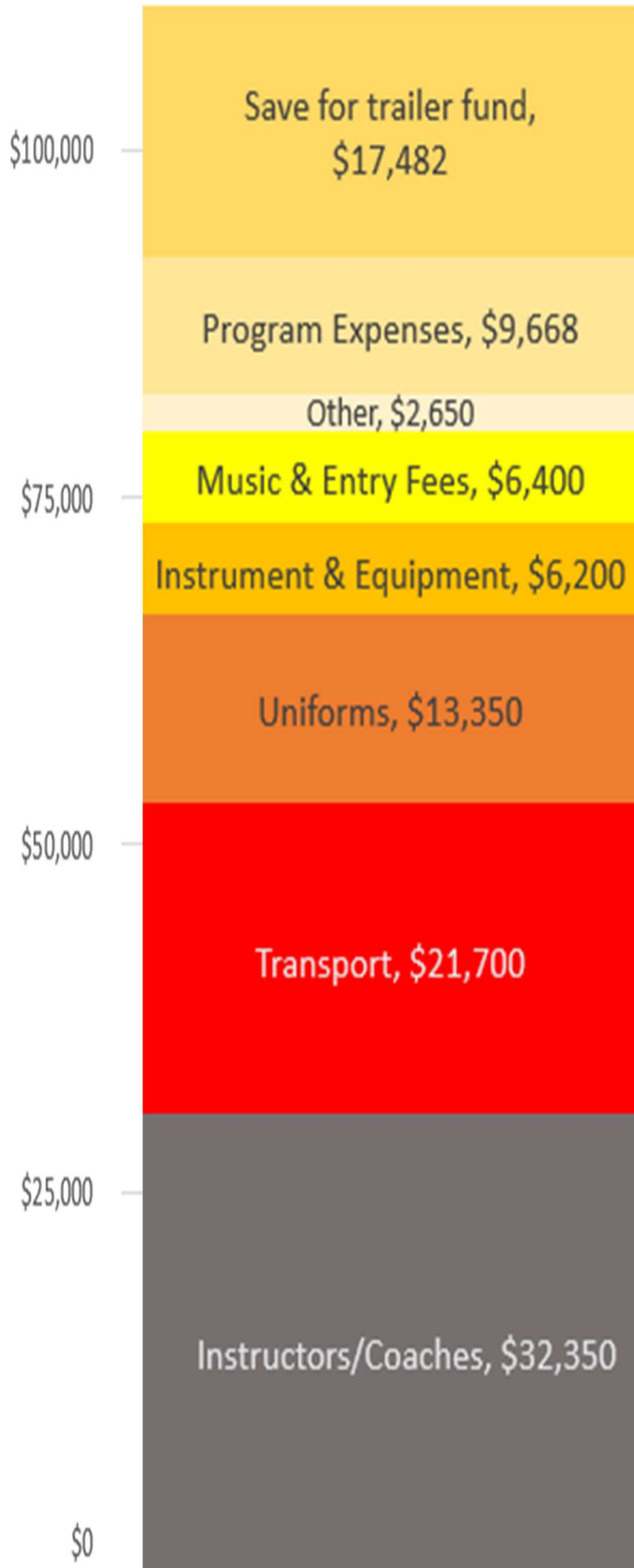


For 2024/25, our goal is to raise almost \$110,000 to support our musical programs.

We do this through:

- ♫ **Fair Share:** We ask families to contribute a share of the cost of their student's program(s) that covers less than half of the running costs of those programs.
- ♫ **Fundraisers:** Family dinner nights (e.g Melos, Ale House), Farm Fresh, Holiday Pie Sales, PepWear, Twilight Tasting, Raffles.
- ♫ **Fiesta:** Hosted by the City of Livermore Guard, this annual fundraiser benefits the entire musical community!
- ♫ **Sponsorship:** Our generous sponsors in 2023-2024 were CHEF, the Vaughn Family, Vintage Home Loans, Alyssa & Sonia Gonzalez, Vulcan Materials, Madison Vineyards, and Emma's Grandma. This year we hope to expand the number of sponsors, with a goal of \$20,000.
- ♫ **Bingo:** Granada Supporters reimburse us generously for every hour we work to support bingo. Sign up to help out using the link on our website.

## Where does the money go?



♪ 30% of the budget is spent on coaches and instructors. This year we're adding a choir accompanist.

♪ 20% of the budget goes towards bus and equipment truck rentals for offsite competitions

♪ 12% of the budget is used to maintain and replace guard, band, and drumline uniforms. It costs over \$3,000 to dry clean marching uniforms every summer.

♪ We spend almost \$10,000 on operating costs, including the music T-shirts given to every student, insurance, accounting fees, student awards, varsity letter patches, office expenses, subscription services, basic supplies, and our website.

♪ With your help, we want to raise at least \$17,000 to buy an equipment trailer, which would eliminate significant ongoing truck rental costs.
